

# **GIFT GIVING GUIDE**

Formed in 1878, the UW-Madison Department of Geoscience has an illustrious history. Amongst its early scholars were John Muir, Florence Bascom, who was UW's 2nd M.S. (1887) and GSA's first female member (1894), and Thomas Chamberlin and Charles Van Hise, who each served as UW presidents and respectively founded the UW Extension and birthed the still-vibrant "Wisconsin Idea".

The department evolved to its modern form in 1974, when it moved into the Lewis G. Weeks Hall, a modern facility built with a \$3.6 million gift from Lewis Weeks. Subsequent Weeks family gifts built an endowment whose transformative effects ripple to the present. The department, now consisting of 20 faculty members and its highly-trained staff and students, has educated generations of undergraduate and graduate students and remains a leader in geoscientific research and education 140 years after its founding.
